The Brevard County Parks and Recreation Department will be offering summer camp to ages 6-11 at community centers throughout the county, starting June 15, **for parents who are returning to work.**

- At this time no day registrations will be accepted, only weekly registrations. Those previously registered for Summer Camp this summer will be given priority registration.
- Camp will be offered from 7:30 a.m. 5:30 p.m. on Monday through Friday, beginning June 15.
 Camps will include mandatory temperature checks for campers and staff members. Children will not be admitted to camp if their temperature is 100.4 degrees or higher.
