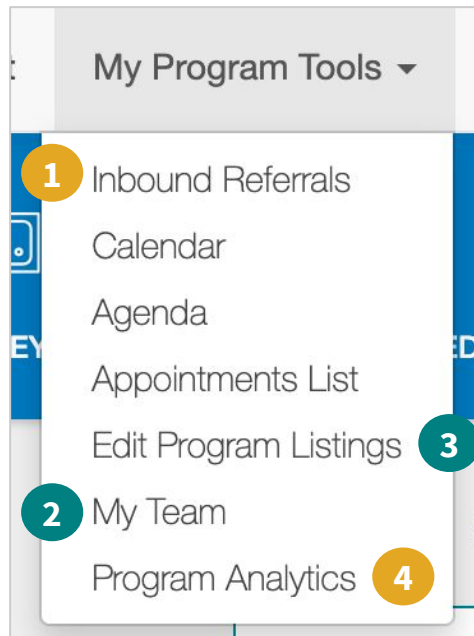
After Your Claim → Free Tools

1. Inbound Referrals

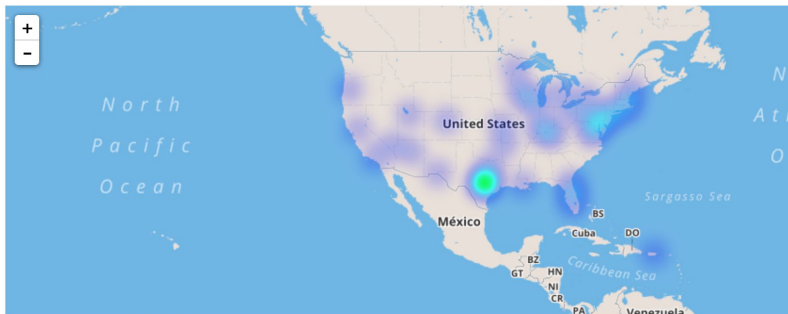

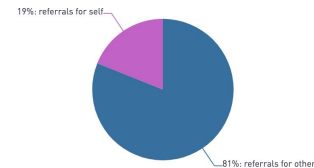

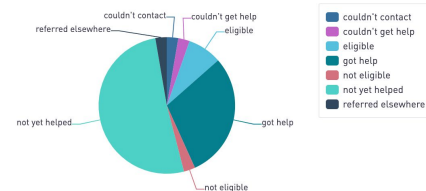
